



# National Youth Leadership Training Participant Information

## Uniforms (Scouts and Varsity Scouts)

- Full official uniform, including pants and/or shorts, socks and shoes. You will wear your Scout pants or shorts the full 6 days, and your uniform shirt about half the time.
- Uniforms of all vintages are appropriate.
- Scout-related T-shirts for the time you're not wearing your uniform shirt.
- Official BSA cap, or no hat is ok.
- Neckerchief will be provided – arrive wearing your neckerchief of your home Unit.

## Uniforms (Venturing Crew Members)

- Crew's official uniform, including pants and/or shorts, or dress pant, and socks and shoes. You will wear your uniform pants or shorts for the full 6 days, and your uniform shirt about half the time.
- Scout-related T-shirts for the time you're not wearing your uniform shirt.
- Official BSA cap, or no hat is ok.
- Neckerchief will be provided – arrive wearing neckerchief of home Unit, if applicable

## Rain – Be Prepared for weather of any kind.

- Raingear – bring the best you can.
- Warm layers in case it is cool and light layers in case it is hot.
- Sun screen in case it isn't raining.

## Do **NOT** bring

- Stoves
- Food of any kind.
- Electronics
- Cell Phones – they won't work at camp.

This is expected of you. On your Scout's honor.
