- Adults and Youth Volunteers: proof of SYT (YPT) and CPR/First Aid if applicable

Daily Expectations

Bring Each Day:

- Camp shirt (provided Day 1 – must be worn each day)
- Closed-toe shoes (no sandals or crocs)
- Hat, labeled water bottle
- Sack lunch in insulated bag

Do Not Bring:

- Electronics
- Knives or Scout tools
- Matches/fire starters
- Unregistered siblings

Label all items. Lost & Found will be at Headquarters.

Please apply sunscreen and bug spray before arrival. All medications must be checked in with medical staff.

Arrival & Dismissal

- Park and walk your Scout in and out.
- Photo ID required for pickup.
- Scouts released only to approved individuals.
- Early departures must check out at Headquarters.

Volunteers

Camp runs on volunteers. If you are attending as a volunteer, please make sure you register on BlackPug! If your Pack is bringing multiple Scouts, additional adult support is appreciated.

Setup is Sunday (10-6 PM); teardown is Friday (3-6 PM). We welcome anyone who is able to come help set up!

There is a required training for staff (station leaders, den walkers, and youth staff) on Sunday from 10-6pm. We will send out more information about this training at a later date. This training is required for those listed above, but open to anyone who would like to join!
