Dr. Michael Bourke is a licensed clinical and forensic psychologist and retired U.S. federal law enforcement officer with decades of experience protecting youth and combating child exploitation. He served as Chief Psychologist for the U.S. Marshals Service, where he founded and led the Behavioral Analysis Unit, working on high-profile cases worldwide and personally evaluating more than 1,000 offenders. Co-author of the landmark Butner Study, he has published extensively on safeguarding, offender risk, and first responder wellness, and authored three books on behavioral criminology.

A sought-after trainer and consultant, Dr. Bourke has presented for the FBI, CIA, U.S. Secret Service, United Nations, and law enforcement agencies in over 30 countries. He serves on the faculty of The George Washington University's Forensic Psychology Program, is a founding board member of Raven, and is the National Chair of the Youth Protection Committee for Scouting America.



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
