- **Gold Panning Activity** - We propose gold panning at the Resurrection River gravel bar, which is shallow and easy to access. We also have an indoor facility with elevated troughs and a custom vinyl covering that can be used if the weather is unfavorable, but I thought as your group is a bunch of scouts, that the river would be a more desirable and authentic location.

### **Overview:**

Depending on the size of the groups, we can have one or more guides for each group. A guide will provide instruction on panning and a brief geology lesson on quartz and gold prospecting in Alaska. The guide will also display samples of a quartz vein and an antique gold pan, explaining the other multi uses that the old timers used (an interesting story for sure). Each participant receives a bag of paydirt guaranteed to contain at least two pieces of gold that we put into the dirt. We sometimes find gold that was not put into the bag by us but was recovered with the materials we have dug up in various locations around Seward. We also provide glass vials to contain the gold.

- **Sea Kayaking:** We offer several sea kayaking tours and can provide rain gear, poggies and other necessary equipment. All trips use tandem kayaks.

**Tonsina Point Kayaking:** A scenic paddle along the coast of Resurrection Bay. This is a fantastic introduction to sea kayaking in the wildlife field.

**Bridal Veil Falls Paddle:** A fun paddle to Bridal Veil Falls Beach and back to Lowell Point Beach with a small hike to the multi-tiered waterfall. The scouts can bring lunch and eat on the beach before or after the hike.

**Aialik Glacier Full Day paddle** : This is a combination of whale/wildlife watching boat tour and kayaking experience. Visiting the sea lion haul outs, bird rookeries, and scenic coastal sights as you travel by on a 23-passenger vessel (landing craft) to and back from Aialik Glacier in the heart of the Kenai Fjords National Park. Once at Aialik Bay the boat goes to the cache site where our kayaks are stashed and the kayaking portion of the trip begins. The guides will discuss a bit of glacier safety and kayaking instructions, with that done the group will paddle towards the calving glacier maintaining a safe distance from the face of the glacier. A wrap lunch and hot drinks are included. This is a full day tour offered at 7:10am and returns between 5:30pm - 6 pm.

**Bear Glacier Heli Kayak:** This helicopter-kayaking combination is the most amazing trip with an unmatched scenic 10-15 min helicopter flight from Seward Airport to Bear Glacier Lagoon where the largest glacier in the Kenai Fjords National Park is located along with its incredible huge icebergs. This trip is actually 2 trips in one with the helicopter flights being the most

incredible views of the coast and an over the top view of Bear Glacier and all of its icebergs. We land at our kayak camp which is located directly within view of the glacier with icebergs everywhere. We paddle from the camp and paddle around some of the largest icebergs in this part of Alaska.
