Deadline to Register: September 24th, 2026

Prerequisite: Online BALOO Training

(Must be completed prior to in-person training)

You can find it through your my.scouting.org account. After logging in, click Menu, My Training, Cub Scouts, Catalog, and scroll down to find the course. It takes about 45 minutes to complete.

What to Bring:

Tent with ground cloth, sleeping bag, sleeping pad/air mattress (optional), uniform, change of clothes, sleep attire, toiletry kit, Cub Scout 6 essentials (see Tiger, Wolf, Bear or Webelos handbook), COFFE MUG (very important), coat or jacket, hat, gloves, poncho or rain gear, pen/pencil, anything else needed for an overnight campout.
