Cubs checking in at 1:00 will participate in the BobCat Adventure and various activities during the afternoon.

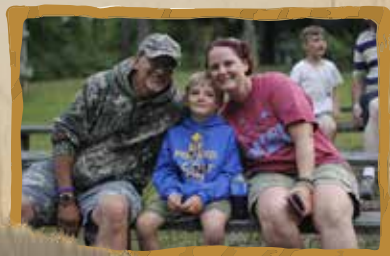
Cubs checking in at 5PM will join just in time for the Outdoor Adventure and Cub Camp Cooking for dinner!

AOL ADVENTURES

BOBCAT

The Bobcat Adventure is the first required Adventure on your Trail and will get you and your patrol on to a great start. Once you have completed the Bobcat Adventure, you can work on the other Adventures in any order. In this Adventure, you'll learn about things like the Scout slogan and the patrol method. You'll find out about ranks in Scouting America and merit badges. And you'll visit a Scouting America troop.

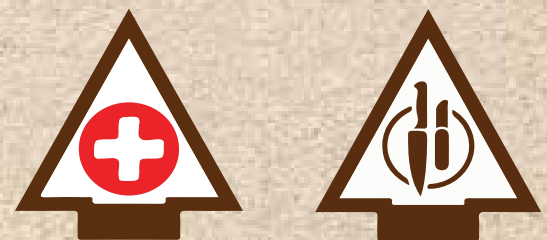


OUTDOOR ADVENTURE


There's nothing like the great outdoors. In this Adventure, you will plan and participate in a campout with your Arrow of Light patrol or a Scouting America troop. You'll learn how to pack, help plan using Scouting America's SAFE Checklist, set up camp, and discover how Scouts camp.

FIRST AID

In this Adventure, you will learn how to protect yourself and how to help others when they have been hurt. The skills you learn in this Adventure could help someone in trouble or even save a life. Your patrol may have a trained professional like an emergency medical technician (EMT), medical doctor, or registered nurse provide AOL Adventures instruction for this Adventure.



KNIFE SAFETY

A knife is a tool. A pocketknife or multipurpose tool is one of the Scout Basic Essentials.  At campouts, you will be preparing your own food. It's more than likely you'll use a kitchen knife. In this Adventure, you will learn the safety rules about using a knife and some basic instructions on how to use a pocketknife and kitchen knife.



This Adventure allows you as an Arrow of Light Scout to use a knife, with adult permission, during Cub Scout activities. Your pocket certificate for this Adventure may serve as proof you have heard this Adventure.

Leadership Requirements

AOL Units attending FSE are required to have two-deep leadership. AOL Cub Scouts attending with a Scouts BSA troop or Venturing crew are regarded as a separate unit and must have their own additional adult leadership in accordance with Safeguarding Youth Policy. Any Scouting unit that includes AOL Cub Scouts must provide designated two-deep leadership for each unit.

All adults camping overnight at Fort Steuben MUST be a registered member of Scouting





PROVISIONAL CAMPING

Provisional camping is a program that allows individual Scouts to attend camp without their home pack.

At FSE, Scouts may choose to join a troop or pack or be added to a dedicated “provisional pack” where any AOL unit or parent may stay.
