

Blue and Gray Camporee Campaign Patch Requirements

13. Visit the Philippi Public Library-What was on display? **Close at 4PM**	
14. Introduce yourself to General James Longstreet and ask a question about the Civil War.	
15. Have Soldier’s Stew and Hard Tack for Lunch in camp. 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM	
16. Relax at late campfire and talk United States News Topics 11:30 PM to 12:30 PM
