WELCOME TO THE 2020 KLONDIKE DERBY AT CAMP MAHONEGON!

The committee is looking forward to presenting another great and memorable experience for everyone. As with last year, we are following an open-schedule format. This means that there are no set times for stations, except for lunch. (Each patrol will be assigned a time for lunch and will be evaluated and scored as part of the overall competition.)

The open-schedule format is used so that the scouts can plan their day (being THRIFTY with their time) and let them brush up on skills in stations where they may need some work.

A score of 10 points can also be earned by each Patrol that has <u>every</u> scout spending the night at camp on Friday night in a **TENT** that they have helped pitch. A score of 8 points will be awarded to those Patrols that spend the night in an Adirondack.

We are trying to gear our Klondike to promote good leadership and teamwork. MAKE SURE YOUR PATROL:

- Shows SCOUT SPIRIT.
- Has a Patrol cheer.
- Finds the station leader and asks for permission to enter the station.

In addition to Scout Skills, time management and planning will need to be used. If a station is full, a patrol may need to find an open station to attend. Lunch will work on a 3 lunch time rotation. Stations will also be closed on a rotating basis for lunch times as well.

Each patrol should bring:

- A supply of firewood
- 1/4 "rope that can be cut for lashings (preferably not nylon rope)
- First Aid Kit
- Water
- Compass
- Handbook
- Patrol flag
- Whatever else is necessary to BE PREPARED!

Each patrol and sled will also be evaluated and scored after flag raising. This will be based upon their gear and how prepared the scouts are for the weather conditions.

The purpose of the Klondike Derby is to:

- Build teamwork and leadership
- Improve Scout Skills
- Promote a healthy competition
- Have FUN!

We hope that everyone has a great time! If the weather is cold, there are plenty of places to take time out to warm themselves.

REGISTRATION AND FEES
