

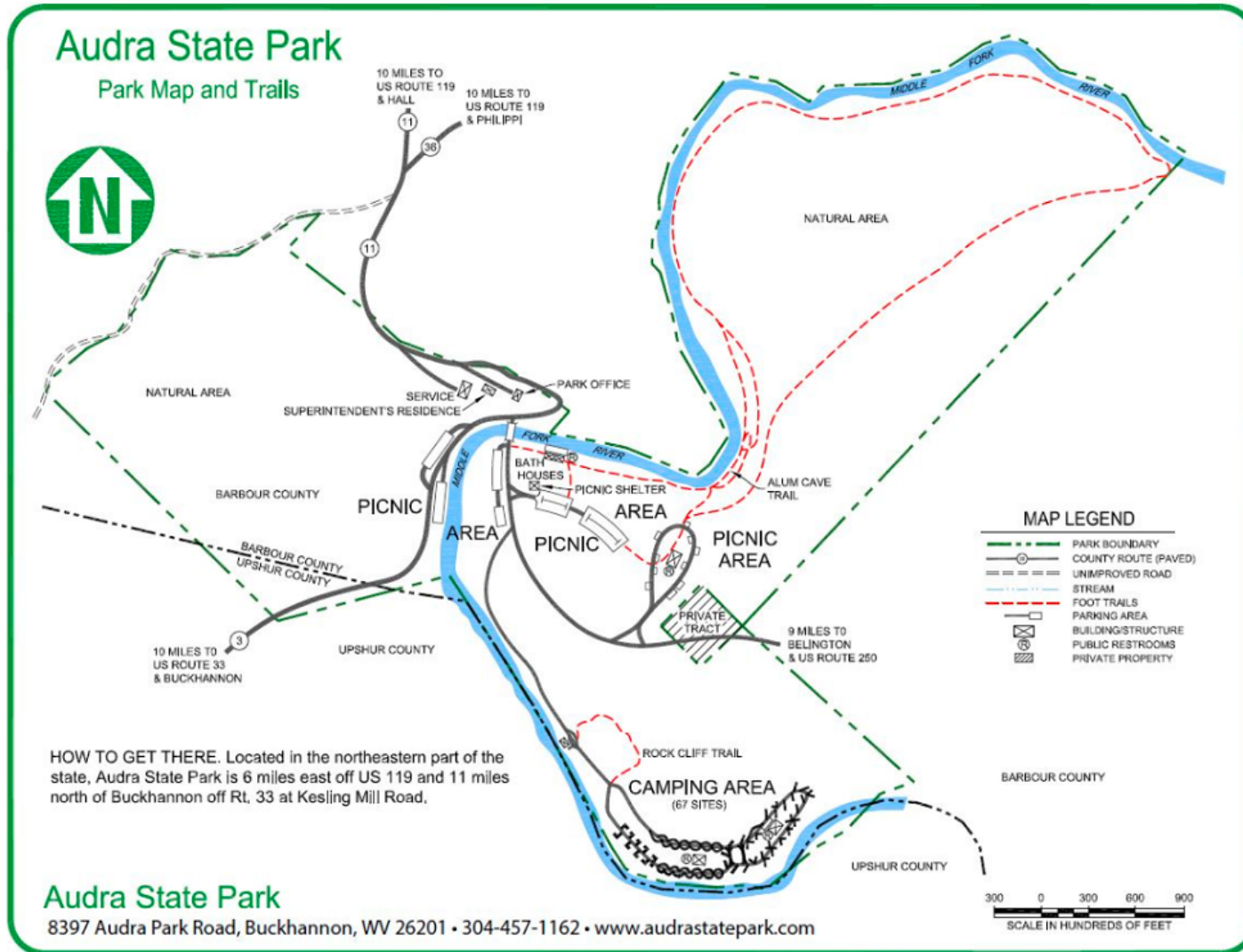


Barbour County, Audra State Park 8397 Audra Park Rd, Buckhannon, WV

A beautiful state park on the Middle Fork River. Take a hike to see the Alum Trail and beautiful views along the river. Bring your bathing suit and towel and you might even get a chance to take a dip!

- Parking along the river or by the Pavilion will get you to Alum Creek and Cave Trail.
- Easier start: If you start at the beach area and head towards the cave, you'll go by the restrooms and by the river. Go left to head to the caves from the upper trail (recommended for the easier hike). You should see the boardwalk start almost immediately. When you reach the stairs on the boardwalk you can turn around and go back the way you came or continue up the steps and on down the trail. Another option is to go to the top of the steps and turn right to return to parking.
- Feel free to do the longer trail as an out and back or as a loop. The upper part of the loop will have elevation depending on the direction of your travel. We, personally, like doing an out and back along the river. Be an inner explorer and do a loop if you want your whole hike to be different. Recommended parking in the Picnic Area to START on the upper part of the loop.
