## **Basic Information / Safety**

- 1. Fee for the Camporee is \$10.00 per scout if pre-registered and prepaid by April 1, 2022; \$15.00, April 2-April 28, 2022 or \$25 at the door. \*Doddridge County youth, not currently registered with the BSA will be free for Saturday activities and must be accompanied by an adult.
- 2. First 150 to register will receive a patch.
- 3. The fee includes a Camporee patch, program materials, and insurance cost.
- 4. Meals are **NOT** provided. Cracker Barrel snacks will be provided both nights.
- 5. Patches will be given to units at the close of the event (after the worship service).
- 6. Patrols will be provided a schedule of the activities and times they are scheduled to participate in each activity.
- 7. Patrols must follow trails and/or roads to reach all stations. Pushing, shoving, harassing, blocking or hindering any other patrol will not be tolerated. As always, proper Scout conduct is expected throughout the event.
- 8. In the event of you or someone in your patrol gets hurt, you should contact the nearest adult leader immediately. In the event of an emergency refer to the Emergency Information Sheet provided.
- 9. All meals are the responsibility of the Patrol. Patrols should plan to cook meals in their campsite
- 10. Campsites are obtained on a first come, first served basis. Parking is very limited, make every effort to carpool. Only one vehicle and Trailer may be parked on the parking pad at each campsite. No vehicle may be parked in the road.
- 11. For safety, closed toe shoes are required.

#### **Rules of Conduct**

- 1. Fires must stay in the fire rings
- 2. All Scouts and Leaders must wear Scout Uniform or Scout T-Shirt (Class A or Class B shirts)
- 3. All Scouts need to be in their tent area from 10:00pm until 7:00am
- 4. Remember the <u>Outdoor Code</u> and <u>Leave no Trace</u> principles at all times within the Doddridge County Park
- 5. Comply with all posted Park rules.
