As a Scout, the Troop in Tom's community shut down after no adults would serve as Scoutmaster. As District Chairman, Tom's commitment to Scouting derived from his desire to make sure no Scout would be without a unit.

The Helmsman Award is presented to a Scouter for transformational leadership at a unit level. Examples of transformational leadership include, but are not limited to, turning around a struggling unit, repairing a relationship with a chartered organization, significantly increasing advancement or camp attendance, etc. The Scouter must have at least one year's service to Scouting and shown successful cooperation between a local unit and Wisconsin River District. One may only receive this award once.
