

Driftless Navigator Award Nomination

The Driftless Navigator Award is presented to registered Scouters for their noteworthy volunteer service above and beyond normal expectations at the unit and/or District level. A limited number are presented each year and are chosen by the District Awards committee from eligible nominees

Nominations are confidential. Award Committee decisions are also confidential until the District Dinner, but the nominator will be notified and has the option to inform the awardee in advance. The unit Committee Chair, if applicable, will also be informed.

The award is presented at the annual District Dinner, April 16, 2025. The awardee should register to attend the dinner or an alternate presentation can be scheduled.

Eligibility

- ✓ The nominee must be a currently registered adult leader, 18+ years, in the Driftless District;
- ✓ The nominee must have noteworthy service above normal expectations in either their unit or the Driftless District (or its predecessor Districts);
- ✓ The nominee cannot have received the Driftless Navigator Award before (this is a new award in 2025);
- ✓ The nominator can be any adult Scouter. A unit Committee Chair will be notified of any unit awardees.
