- KNOTS:
  - Overhand knot
  - Square knot
  - Bowline
  - 2 half hitches
  - Taut line hitch
  - Possibly how to whip and fuse ends of rope
  - For each knot show how and why used
    - These are used in AOL outdoorsman #4, Scouting Adventures 5A and 5B, Wolf call of wild #5, Bear Necessities #4
- Flag Ceremony
  - AOL Building a Better world #1
    - Help lead a flag ceremony
    - Explain history of US Flag
    - Show how to properly display a flag in public
  - Bears Paws for Action #1
    - Say Pledge of Allegiance and learn its meaning
    - Learn about nation's flag
  - Wolf Council Fire #1
    - Participate in flag ceremony and properly care and see how a flag is folded.

- Hike
  - All ranks need
    - What are 6 essentials?

- What evidence do you see while on hike of wildlife or nature?
    - List: birds, insects, mammals, plants, trees...about two or three of each
    - What is buddy system? What do you do if get lost while on hike?
  - The hike counts as
    - Tigers in wild #4, #6
    - Tiger Jungle #1, #2, #3
    - Wolf Paws on Path #1, #2, #5, #6
    - Bears fur, feathers, and ferns #1
- Team building games:

      - Archery
        - Wolf/Bear: tell 5 facts of archery in history or literature
        - Webelos/AOL: tell 5 facts of archery in history or literature
      - Sling shot
        - For all ranks: Shoot 5 shots at target 3 times to improve score
- Bird House Building:
  - Bears: Baloo the Builder
    - #1: tools use and rules when using
    - #2: Select appropriate tools needed
    - #3: part b: make a useful project
    - #4: apply a finish to the project (Don't know if applying at this camp)
  - Webelos/AOL: Build It
    - #1: basic tools needed and knowledge of each tool
    - #2 : Select carpentry project and build it
    - #3: List the tools you used and put a check by list if it is the 1<sup>st</sup> time
- Compass course/mock dig site:
  - Bears: Fur/Feathers/Fin
    - #3: tell one animal that is extinct over last 100 years, list one animal current that is endangered, what is possibly the cause for the decline
  - Wolves:
