# CUB SCOUT GAMES WINTERFEST DETAILS

## WHO

- Cub Scouts who want to test their skills participating in Winterfest (including Lion and Tiger Cubs).

## WHEN

- Saturday, Feb 11, 2023
- Check-in begins at 12:30 pm
- Flag Ceremony at 1:00 pm
- Event ends at 5:00 pm

## HOW MUCH

- \$10.00 per Scout
- Adult / Leaders / Volunteers - Free

## REGISTRATION

- Must register on-line (There will be NO on-site registration)
- Groups larger than 8 scouts will be broken up into two groups for this event (there is some wiggle room in this number)
- Registration deadline: Wednesday Feb 8, 2023 (by 8 pm)

## CHECK-IN

- **DON'T NOT CHECK IN until your entire group has arrive - SEND ONE ADULT / LEADER to check your group in with all the proper forms, etc.**
- Bring your Health forms Part A and B to show you have them – **you will keep them with you**
- Upon check in, maps and rotation schedules will be distributed at that time.

## MEALS

- All Participants and volunteers **should eat lunch prior** to the event.

## LEADERSHIP

Each unit must have at a minimum two registered adult leaders during the event at all times as well as:

1. One adult for every five youth minimum.
  - a. Lion and Tiger Scouts must have an adult Lion or Tiger Partner with them.

## HEALTH & SAFETY

Every scout and adult attending camp must have with them a current BSA Health Form with Parts A and B completed. Unit leaders should collect and review all medical forms prior to event and keep in their possession for review.

The event will have a "health officer" on staff for the duration of the Winterfest for more serious situations. However, if a medical emergency occurs, dial 911 immediately.

Youth Protection policies must be adhered to at all times and are especially important in relation to photography use. Failure to comply with Youth Protection policies may result in scouts or adults being asked to leave the camp without refund. Your agreement to this is recognized by registration to this event.

## DRESS CODE

**\*\*\* THE EVENT WILL BE HELD OUTDOORS – PLEASE HAVE ALL PARTICIPANTS DRESS APPROPRIATELY\*\*\***

Please dress appropriately for the weather. Most of the grounds are wide open and you could be subject to temperature extremes (cold), intense sun and wind.

Cold Weather comfort - Warm clothes

- a. Dress appropriately for the weather: boots, hat, gloves and so on.
- b. Extra clothes as the Scouts Adult partner deems suitable.
- c. We will have a building available to warm up in if needed by participants and volunteers.
