1. Do TWO of the following, choosing a different group for each: a. Go to a festival, celebration, or other event identified with one of the groups. Report on what you see and learn. b. Go to a place of worship, school, or other institution identified with one of the groups. Report on what you see and learn. c. Talk with a person from one of the groups about the heritage and traditions of the group. Report on what you learn.

d. Learn a song, dance, poem, or story that is traditional to one group, and teach it to a group of your friends. e. Go to a library or museum to see a program or exhibit featuring one group's traditions. Report on what you see and learn.
