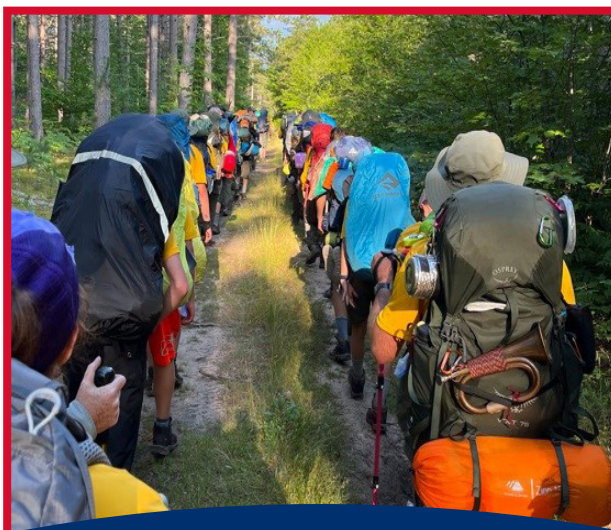


Course fee is \$300 if paid before June 5, 2023.

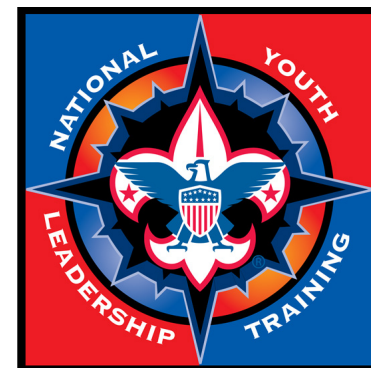

WHAT IS NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING PACK AND PADDLE?

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) prepares Scouts, Venturers, and Sea Scouts to provide enthusiastic and competent leadership in their Troops, Crews and Ships, using the Patrol Method.

NYLT Pack and Paddle accomplishes this by participation in an 9-day wilderness trek, modeling a month in the life of a Troop. Participants live and work together as a patrol on a backpack and canoe trek in the backcountry of Camp Hiawatha and the Hiawatha National Forest.

This is a Leadership Training Course, NOT a skills instruction course or high adventure trek, although it does have elements of both.



LA GRANDE PORTAGE

Do you have what it takes to earn the coveted Paddle? (A unique qualification device worn from your right pocket flap.)

While the entire course is a trek, the final three days and two nights are an adventure deep into the Hiawatha National Forest on foot and by canoe.

You and your patrol put together all that you have learned about leadership and teamwork to complete the trek and earn the Paddle.
