



SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Always follow the BSA's [Guide to Safe Scouting](#).
- Do not go into unsafe areas or places you feel uncomfortable.
- Be aware of “No Solicitation” signs, gated communities, etc.
Communicate
 - ahead of time for drop offs or skip these.
 - Use the buddy system and be safety conscious.
 - No 1 on 1 contact between youth and adults.
 - Use extreme caution when crossing streets.
 - Never ride in the back of pickups or trailers.
 - Never enter a home.
 - Do not enter fenced yards or walk across lawns.
 - Use sidewalks when possible.
 - Always wear seatbelts when riding in a vehicle.
 - Monitor the weather, be prepared to alter your plans and dress.

 - Always make sure a minimum of 2 adults accompanies all scouts.
 - Wear your Scout uniform.
 - Be friendly and courteous to everyone.
 - Thank people even if they don't contribute.
