**How much time does this really take?**

This is often the question we get as recruiters to the course. The short answer is the time commitment is the 2 weekends for the course and the time to work your ticket.

**No really how much time does this really take?**

Seriously, 2 weekends, plus the ticket.

**What's a ticket?**

The ticket develops the leader primarily for Scouting but the lessons translate across teams, families, and communities.

This is a self-directed portion of the program where you demonstrate mastery of the skills taught on course. A ticket counselor will be assigned to help you with this process. It can be completed in as little as a few months but a maximum of 18 months.

**What if I don't have any scouting experience?**
