Due to extra measures related to Covid-19, our course will be limited to the first 48 paid registrations.

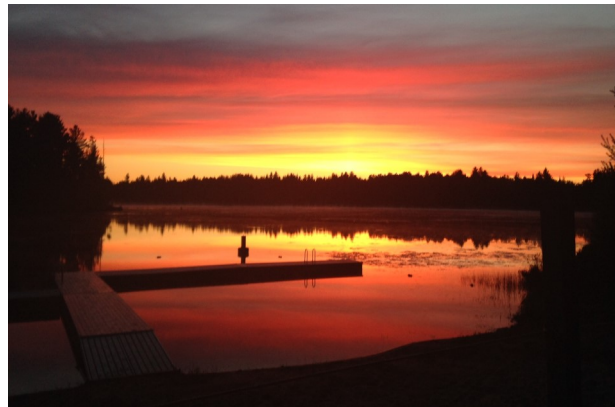

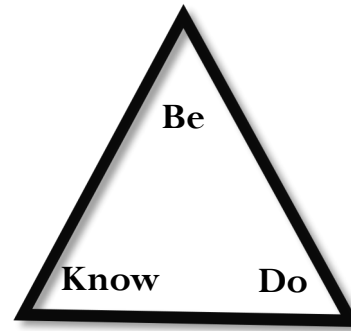




## What is National Youth Leadership Training?

National Youth Leadership Training is an action-packed program designed to provide Scouts with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home units and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. This program is the centerpiece of the Bay-Lakes Council's youth training opportunities, providing local units with outstanding youth leaders and giving participants the tools and leadership ideals that will serve them well in whatever they do.

Through modeling and reinforcing patrol method, we simulate a month in the life of a troop, including an overnight outpost camp. This course is led by a youth staff with support from adults, just as Robert Baden-Powell intended Scouting to be.

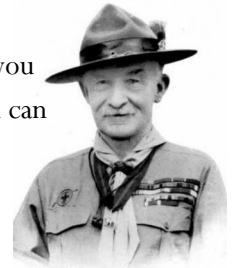
