Discover what inspired the individual, learn about the challenges they faced, and share what you feel attributed to their success. b. Discuss with your counselor what you learned and how you can apply it in your life.

Prerequisite 8: With the help of your parent or guardian, study an event that had a positive outcome on how society viewed a group of people and made them feel more welcome. Describe to your counselor the event and what you learned.
