#### **CAMPING INFORMATION**

Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts camp for free at the State Park. Cub Scouts are allowed to Camp-Over Night <u>ONLY</u> when accompanied by <u>at least</u> <u>1</u> parent or guardian. Cub Scout/Family Camp will be separate from Boy Scouts Troop Camp Sites.

#### MEALS

#### SATURDAY SKILL STATIONS

Each Boy Scout Troop will choose a scout skill or activity to demonstrate to the Cub Scouts (e.g. monkey bridge, fire starting, survival skills, etc.) When the unit chooses a skill please inform Rick Summerton, so that we can plan.
