## About the Three Crowns Golf Club

Designed by Robert Trent Jones, Jr., the course has 110 acres of manicured turf and 45 acres of native grasses. The greens are constructed to USGA standards with A-1 bentgrass surfaces. Kentucky Bluegrass carpets the tees, fairways and roughs.

Robert Trent Jones, Jr. has not disappointed in his consideration of all players. Men will have their choice of challenge from either the Black, Gold or White teeing areas. From the Red or White tees, women will enjoy the excellent conditions, generous fairways and receptive greens.

The course also features a 13 acre Practice Facility with a course condition practice green, two bunkers, short game area and 300 yard driving range provide golfers an excellent opportunity to improve their game.
