SIGN-UP PRIORITY:

2022 RIVER RATS PACK: Packs that attended in 2022 will be able to reserve the same weekend as the previous year with a possible adjusted number of attendees in 2023. If space allows, you may be able to move to another weekend.

• If there are any openings after sign-up night, we will accept paid reservations until we reach 250.

NEW PACKS IN 2023: After all "Returning Packs", available space will be open to **new** Packs.

• New Packs once registered/paid will receive the same weekend the following year (2024).

ROSTERS: Names, emails ans shirt sizes are due at sign-up night. Forms located at www.camplonglake.org.

SHIRT SIZES: Due before **March 23, 2023**, otherwise:

- · Youth will receive an Adult Small
- · Adults will receive an Adult XL

ACTIVITY SESSIONS: As a **Pack** you will be asked to plan an activity (assigned at sign-up night).

REFUND POLICY:

The \$20 deposit is TRANSFERABLE to another Scout but NON-REFUNDABLE

- Refunds will only be considered before March 23, 2023 for extenuating circumstances of (Documented injury/illness, death in the family, etc.).
- · After March 23, 2023, the maximum refund will be 50% of the balance minus the deposit.
- \cdot All refund requests must be in writing (PAC Refund Form).
