What is Wood Badge?

Wood Badge embodies nearly a century of Scouting experience and draws on contemporary leadership models from corporate America, academia, and successful organizations nationwide.

Originally created by Baden Powell in 1919, Wood Badge was designed to ensure that Scout troop leaders received proper training. Since then, it has been conducted worldwide, offering advanced leadership training to thousands of Scout leaders.



Why Wood Badge?

By taking Wood Badge, Scouters will gain essential skills in listening, communication, conflict management, project planning, and leading change. Participants will deepen their understanding of diversity and enhance their effectiveness as Scout leaders. Well-trained leaders contribute to a more impactful program for the youth in Scouting. Participants will engage with and internalize the five Wood Badge themes:

- Living the Values, Growing, Connecting, Guiding and Empowering

- All registered adults involved in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts, Exploring, district or council
- 18 years of age or older
- Completed basic training for position (most of which can be taken online at my.scouting.org)

- Completion of Annual Health & Medical Record (part A, B, and C)
