Two Components of Training:

An online component and a practical hands-on component. Both must be completed to qualify as “trained”. The online component must be completed prior to the practical. It contains introductory and basic information that will be built upon during the practical training. Take the online component at my.scouting.org and bring a copy of your certificate with you to the hands-on course.

Baloo Training is required for at least one leader in all Packs in order to camp overnight with the Pack.

Suggested Gear List:

- Tent
- Sleeping bag & sleeping pad (or cot)
- Camp chair (if desired)
- Change of clothes
- Personal toiletries as required for a campout
- Sturdy shoes
- Completed Medical Form Parts A & B (turned in at registration)
- Sleeping attire
 - It is October, it might be cold at night, we recommend a stocking hat and socks to sleep in
- Notebook, pen, pencil for note-taking
- Weather-appropriate outdoor clothing (jacket, rain jacket, hat, gloves, etc.)
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
