# Backer Campsite





### CAPACITY: 18

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 9

#### NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 1

### Backer

Backer is the first campsite you pass when entering camp, located directly between the Ecology area and the Iroquois Campsite. With one shelter and a capacity of 18, this campsite is great for smaller units, and there is ample space for additional dome-style tents and/or pioneering projects!

### Baden Powell Campsite





#### CAPACITY: 30

### **Baden Powell**

Baden Powell is a quaint campsite on the northwestern side of camp, located between Dan Beard and Lewis campsites. With one shelter and a capacity of 30, this campsite is great for units that like experience a bit more nature while also feeling close to the rest of the camp.

# Cherokee Campsite





### CAPACITY: 54

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 27

NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 4

### Cherokee

Cherokee is the largest campsite at camp, located next to the Cherokee shower house and the climbing tower. With four shelters and a capacity of 54, this campsite is great for a large unit or a few small or medium units, and it's next to one of the two Gaga Ball octagons on camp.

# Chippewa Campsite





### CAPACITY: 18

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 9

NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 1

### Chippewa

Chippewa is another campsite placed near the center of camp, located next to McHenry campsite, the Show & Do shelter, and one of the camp's Gaga Ball octagons. With one shelter and a capacity of 18, this campsite is great for a medium unit or linked units, and It's right next to all of the action and fun that is the Gaga Ball.

# Clark Campsite





### CAPACITY: 14

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 7

#### NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 1

### Clark

Clark is a small campsite on the western side of camp, located right next to Lewis campsite and just across the parade field from the Climbing Tower. With one shelter and a capacity of 14, this campsite is great for small units and linked units with ample space for dome-style tents and pioneering projects.

### **Dan Beard**

Dan Beard is a semi-secluded campsite placed at the northwestern side of camp, located just down the road from Baden Powell campsite and not far from the Kit Carson Trail. With one shelter and a capacity of 30, this campsite is great for units that like to experience more nature and don't mind hiking a little bit more to get around camp.

# Iroquois Campsite





### CAPACITY: 36

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 18

#### NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 2

### Iroquois

Iroquois is located right next to Backer campsite and not far from the Trading post. With two shelters and a capacity of 36, this campsite is great for a large unit or a few smaller units, and it is located right next to a new Hammock area that safely holds 12 hammocks.

# Lewis Campsite





### CAPACITY: 34

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 17

#### NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 2

### Lewis

Lewis is a larger campsite on the western side of camp, located right next to Clark campsite and the Sinquefield Invention Campus.With two shelters and a capacity of 34, this campsite is great for a large unit, linked unit, or multiple units, and it is located right next to the newest single person bathrooms and showers at camp.

# **McHenry Campsite**





### CAPACITY: 28

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 14

NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 1

### McHenry

McHenry is a campsite placed near the center of camp, located next to Show & Do shelter, the trading post, and the trail to the rifle range. With one shelter and a capacity of 28, this campsite is great for a unit with scouts headed across the camp or for units who don't want to travel too far to get a slushie.

# Osage Campsite





### CAPACITY: 50

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 25

#### NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 4

### Osage

Osage is the second-largest campsite at camp, located right next to the Sinquefield Invention Campus.With four shelters and a capacity of 50, this campsite is great for one large unit or a few small-medium units, and it is just a short hike away from the Osage Lookout - a scenic, clifftop view overlooking Lake of the Ozarks.



CAPACITY: 14

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 7

NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 1

### Seton

Seton is the most centrally located campsite at camp, located right next to the Central shower house. With one shelter and a capacity of 14, this ADA friendly campsite is great for a small unit, and it has a lot of space for both pioneering projects and additional dome-style tents as needed.

### Shawnee Campsite





### CAPACITY: 24

NUMBER OF CONCRETE TENT PADS: 12

NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 1

### Shawnee

Shawnee is the campsite furthest from the entrance of the camp but closest to the lakefront aquatics area. With one shelter and a capacity of 24, this semi-secluded campsite is great for units who don't mind hiking a bit more to get to non-lakefront courses and activities.





#### CAPACITY: 40

#### NUMBER OF SHELTERS: 2

#### Sioux

Sioux is the third-largest campsite at camp. With Sioux nestled not far from the central shower house and the Outdoor Skills area, two shelters, and a capacity for 40, this quaint campsite is great for a linked unit. It aslo has a lot of space for pioneering projects or additional dome-style tents as needed.
