

Visitor Information

ARRIVAL

- ◆ Please arrive on time but no more than 15 minutes prior to your scheduled visit.
- ◆ Upon arrival, proceed to the South pedestrian gate and call the front desk via the intercom to identify yourself and advise the front desk staff of your arrival, who you are visiting and/or the name of the tour group you are with. Once verified, proceed through the gate to the main entrance (see map).
- ◆ Once at the main entrance, use the telephone mounted outside to advise the front desk that you are at the door. They will come meet you at the door.
- ◆ **You must present a valid government issued photo ID when checking in.** All forms of ID must be original. No photocopies are permitted.
- ◆ Personal items such as purses, backpacks and briefcases should not be brought inside the facility unless necessary to the visit. Any such items will be searched upon arrival.
- ◆ **Image capturing or recording device to take photos, video or audio recording within the fenced area is strictly prohibited.** Cell phones are permitted but cannot be used for the above purposes.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are strictly prohibited from being brought on-site and will be confiscated if found:

- ◆ Firearms, knives more than 2.5 inches, explosives or combustible chemical compounds and mixtures, mace, pepper spray, and other dangerous weapons. Possession of these items may be notified to the MU police department.
- ◆ Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, illegal/illicit substances, associated paraphernalia and cannabis.
- ◆ Any and all items that are prohibited by law.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- ◆ Are there attire requirements to tour MURR facility?
 - ◇ Visitors are encouraged to wear closed toe shoes and long pants.
- ◆ How long do the tours last?
 - ◇ Tour length depends on the needs of the group, but typically last between 60 and 90 minutes.
- ◆ Are there age restrictions to attend a tour?
 - ◇ All visitors must be 10 years of age or older.

PARKING INFORMATION

- ◆ Visitors may park in any of the “Reactor Visitor Parking Only” spaces in RP 10 parking lot. If all visitor spaces are occupied, parking is permitted anywhere in RP 10. In this case, visitors must provide the front desk with the make, style, color, and license plate number of the vehicle upon check-in.
- ◆ If you receive a parking ticket from MU Parking, please contact the front desk or your MURR point of contact.
- ◆ MU employees issued a parking permit to another lot or structure on campus may contact MU Parking & Transportation to request permission to park in RP 10.
