
CAMP WIDE ACTIVITIES All Camps

CUB AKELA FAMILY CAMP July 14-July 16


- Cub Akela Family Camp is a three-day/two-night program for Cubs of all ages.




The first two days of all the Cub camps are filled with activities for the **whole family**.




