## CUB ADVENTURE CAMP

July 14-July 17

- Cub Adventure Camp is a four-day, three-night camping program for Wolves and Bears. (Extra fourth-night Optional)
- The program runs concurrently with other Cub Scout Camps.

- Focus is on fun as the primary theme of the camp.
- The camp offers confidence-building experiences.
- Provides opportunities for participants to work on Cub Scout Adventures.
- Aids in rank advancement for the scouts.

## **CUB ADVENTURE CAMP** July 14-July 17

Cub Adventure Camp is a mix of adventures and activities. The schedule is designed for Tigers through Bears (1st-3rd Grade). Each activity block will offer a rank-specific adventure to aid scouts in completing elective adventures for rank advancement or a choice between 2-3 different activities. Cub Scouts will conduct each adventure or activity with other scouts of the same rank. While one rank is conducting an adventure, the other ranks will be participating in an activity of their choice. Cub Scouts that have other family members in Cub Akela Family Camp will also have the opportunity to participate with their family during family activities.

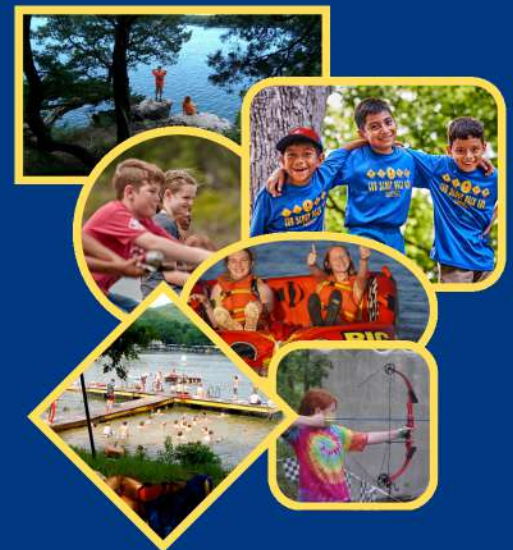

## ARROW OF LIGHT CAMP

July 14-July 18

- Arrow of Light camp lasts five days and four nights, focusing on Arrow of Light Adventures and transition to Scouts BSA.
- Activities are designed to be fun while promoting confidence building and independence.
- Offers pre-programmed activities including aquatics, hiking, and range activities.
- AOL Scouts will engage in outdoor experiences, games, and develop Scouting skills.
- Skills covered include: The Patrol Method, Fire Starting and Building, First Aid, Knots and Lashings, Land Navigation Skills, Outdoor Skills, Hiking
- Camp aims to create lasting memories and prepare scouts for future adventures.

## ARROW OF LIGHT CAMP July 14-July 18

Arrow of Light (AOL) camp will be a representation of a troop to prepare AOL Scouts for their eventual cross-over into the Scouts BSA program. They will start their camp by being divided into patrols and creating an identity within their group. Throughout the week, they will work as a patrol and participate in their activities. Scouts will be going around camp experiencing different areas and offered programs and instruction based on that area's specialty and how the area correlates with the Scout BSA Program. AOL Scouts will also be work on a to patrol meal plan that they will cook during lunch on the last day. The AOL camp will follow the same schedule throughout the week. As with the other camps, AOL Cub Scouts that have other family members in Cub Akela Family Camp will also have the opportunity to participate with their family during family activities.

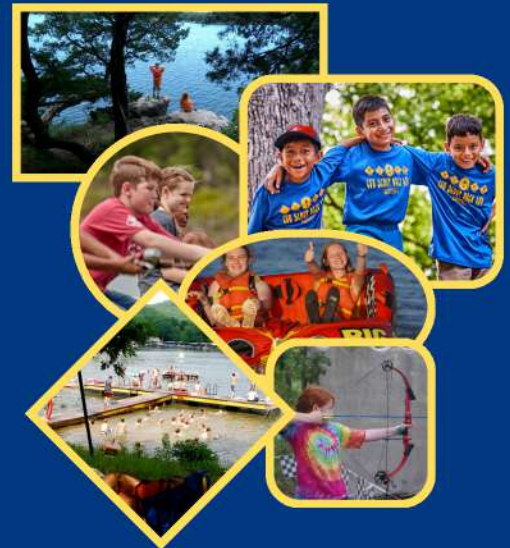
## CHOOSE YOUR OWN FAMILY ADVENTURE

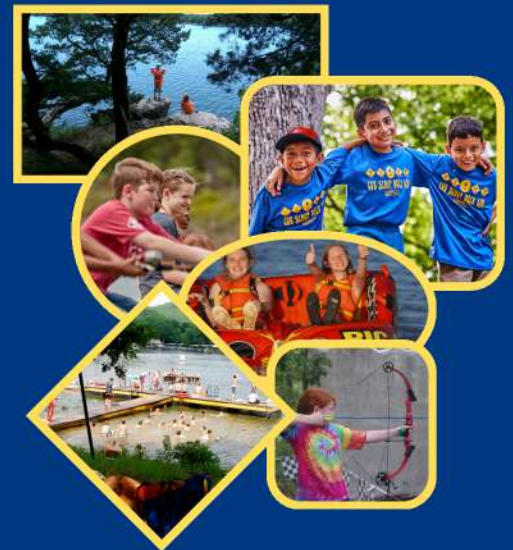

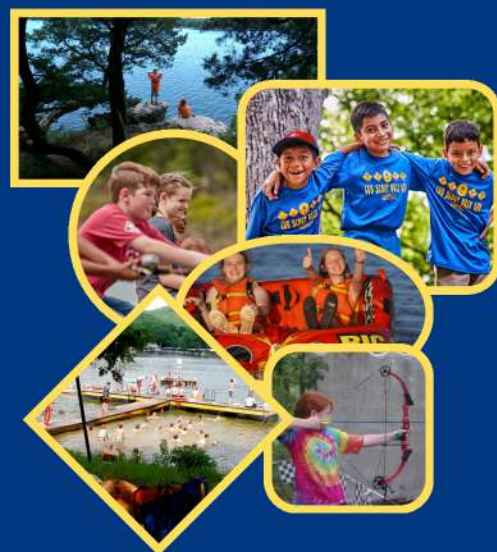
