## Suggested Personal Equipment Checklist

Only the **Home Unit Scout or Venturing uniform** is acceptable for the entire course, including a full uniform shirt and Scout-related T-shirts.

**(Be prepared for an overnight hike as well as living in camp.)**

### Required

Personal Annual Health & Medical Form	Socks (7 pair - BSA)	Small alarm clock
Required or prescribed medication	Shoes for hiking (no sandals)	Watch
Official Uniform shirt (short sleeves)	Raincoat/poncho	Rain pants (recommended)
Official Uniform or solid color shorts (3)	Belt	Light jacket
Scout-related T-shirts (at least 3; course provides 3)	Flashlight & Batteries	Underclothing (6 minimum)
Backpack for overnight	Comb/Brush	Plate, bowl, cup, fork, knife, spoon
Lightweight tent, ground cloth (waterproof), foam pad for overnight hike	Water bottle/canteen	Small daypack or bookbag for daily use
Extra plastic bags to waterproof gear	Camping Cot	Sleeping bag or blankets/sheets
Pajamas if desired	Towels (2)	Ballpoint pen/pencils
Hand soap and container	Shampoo	Notepad
Personal first aid kit	Toothbrush/toothpaste	

### Optional

Scout knife (no sheath knives)	Pillow with case	Hiking socks
Moccasins/lightweight shoes for campsite	Small folding chair	Sunglasses
Extra prescription glasses	Religious book(s)	Insect Repellent
Sunblock/Chapstick	Personal Scouting equipment	Paper

**Note:** All will wear their official home unit uniform for initial photograph. Pack, frame, duffle bag, or small trunk or footlocker must be used for getting gear from the parking area to the campsite. Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued. Also, before coming, see that all badges and insignia are properly placed on uniform shirt. No ball caps or hats with non-Scout logos will be worn.

### DO NOT BRING

- **NO CELL PHONES ARE NEEDED.** Please leave at home or with adults for the week at check-in.
- **NO AXES OR HATCHETS PERMITTED OR ANY FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS OR ITEMS.**
