Work Shops-

Note: There is a lot of good information on the internet.

Stock Classes

All Cub Scout classes are stock and there is an open *(open to all ages)* class that is stock. Stock means all official BSA parts and dimensions. (see official rules sheet that is included with the car kit) I have listed some of the official rules for stock below:

Car weight

Cars can't weigh more that 5 ounces. The car will not weigh this when completed from the kit. Extra weight will need to be added to bring the car to 5 ounces. This is OK. The car will be disqualified if you go over. So, the goal here is to get it as close to 5 ounces without going over. 4.9 oz. is a good weight. Remember paint weighs a little.

Car Dimensions:

Please follow the dimensions exactly as they are in the instructions! No cars stock or modified can be more that 1 inch taller that kit dimensions. Car must be able to pass under timer.

Open Stock

All official rules apply. All ages can race.

Open Modified

Car dimensions are as stock, weight is open, other than that, be creative. You can modify the wheels, use springs, no propulsion allowed unless it is activated by the cars starting motion. Call or text me if you have a question.
