

Description of Awards

Commissioner of the year

A unit commissioner is a commissioner that is assigned to each unit to provide support and resources to the leadership of each unit.

Scoutmaster of the year

The adult responsible for working directly with the Scouts providing direction, coaching, and support for the troop.

Venturing Leader of the year

The Advisor does not have to be an expert in the crew specialty if the crew has one. However, he or she must be a good example for Venturers and must be able to train and coach the crew's elected officers.

District "extra-miler" award

An extra miler is a volunteer who spontaneously offers assistance and advice to other members of their team, and who consistently and creatively looks for improvements and solutions.

District Certificate of Appreciation

A certificate of appreciation is used to acknowledge efforts and award truly deserved volunteers. The person you nominate may have done something within your unit or district such as organize an event or other items that impacted your unit or district.

Cubmaster of the year

The Pack (K-5th Grade) program is developed by the Pack Committee, but the Cubmaster conducts that program. He or she leads the pack meetings.

Leaders of the Year Awards

Lion Den (Kindergarten)

An experienced and engaged Lion den leader is recruited to take the lead on facilitating den meetings with assistance and support from the parents.

Asst. Lion Den (Kindergarten)

An experienced and engaged Lion den leader (kindergarten) is recruited to assist the Lion Den Leader on facilitating den meetings with assistance and support from the parents.

Tiger Den (1st Grade)

An experienced and engaged Tiger den leader (1st Grade) is recruited to take the lead on facilitating den meetings with assistance and support from the parents.

Asst. Tiger Den (1st Grade)

An experienced and engaged Tiger den leader (1st Grade) is recruited to assist the Tiger Den Leader on facilitating den meetings with assistance and support from the parents.

Cub Scout Den

(Wolf: 2nd Grade & Bear: 3rd Grade)

An experienced and engaged Wolf or Bear den leader (2nd or 3rd Grade) is recruited to take the lead on facilitating den meetings.

Asst. Cub Scout Den

(Wolf: 2nd Grade & Bear: 3rd Grade)

An experienced and engaged Wolf or Bear den leader (2nd or 3rd Grade) is recruited to assist the Wolf or Bear Den Leader on facilitating den meetings.

Webelos Den (4th Grade)

An experienced and engaged Webelos den leader (4th Grade) is recruited to take the lead on facilitating den meetings.

Asst. Webelos Den (4th Grade)

An experienced and engaged Webelos den leader (4th Grade) is recruited to assist the leader on facilitating den meetings.

Arrow of Lights Den (5th Grade)

An experienced and engaged AOL den leader (5th Grade) is recruited to take the lead on facilitating den meetings.

Asst. Arrow of Lights Den (5th Grade)

An experienced and engaged AOL den leader (5th Grade) is recruited to assist the leader on facilitating den meetings.

Active Parent of the Year Award

A parent who is not registered as an adult leader but is at every event providing help, support, encouragement, and resources to the unit.
