Bears WOW Activity Adventure Report

Core Adventures

- Have your cub prepare a list of items they should bring for themselves and also what gear the whole family or pack needs to WOW and bring to WOW, bring a tent and have your cub practice setting it up.
(Bear Necessities 1, 2, 3, 4)
- Take a one mile hike, during the hike identify six signs that any mammals, birds, insects, reptiles, or plants are living near Wallwood. Have your cub name an animal that has been extinct for over 100 years and one other animal endangered that lives near Wallwood, see if you can find a wild animal and observe it from a distance
(Fur, Feathers, and Ferns 1, 2, 3, 4)
- Attend the opening or closing flag ceremony and discuss the important parts of the ceremony for reverence to the flag, say the Pledge of Allegiance during one of these flag ceremonies, during First Aid Safety Shenanigans discuss emergency numbers your cub should know, have them demonstrate how to call 911, ask them to name 4 people they could get help from in an emergency beside their parent, pick-up 5 pieces of trash to help clean Wallwood.
(Paws of Action 1 [except for displaying flag at home], 3-B, 4-A)

These activities will allow your cub to earn Bear Necessities, Fur Feather and Ferns, and and earn over half of Paws of Action.

Elective Adventures

- Go down to the dock and fish with Mr. Chuck, learn about three different types of fish that are in Lake Talquin, have your cub draw a picture of those fish, describe the fish habitat at Lake Talquin, learn three fishing regulation and why they exist from Mr. Chuck, learn about the fishing equipment, and fish at the dock for 1 hour.

- Select and bring two nutritious snacks for WOW, visit the cooking class and learn about planning, tool selection, sanitation, and cooking safety, and during the cooking class identify the ingredients you need for the activity, prepare the cooking activity following the recipe, and help get it cooked, clean up your area when done, and then serve to your family.

- Visit the field games and play a game with other cubs, assist a younger cub playing the games.
(Grin and Bear It 1,3)
- Have your cub bring a few jokes that make them laugh to share, bring a tongue twister to share, read a story where other cubs select words to fill in.
(Roaring Laughter 1, 2, 3, 5)
- Make a culture plate at the Fun-Guy class
