This College of Commissioner Science is hosted by the Suwannee River Area Council and will be held at Wallwood Scout Camp, 23 Wallwood BSA Dr, Quincy, FL 32351 <a href="mailto:map">map</a>. The day only registration fee covers the cost associated with course materials, patch, printing, continental breakfast, lunch, certificates, and awards. We are also offering a Weekend Package for \$45. The college is open to all adults registered with the Boy Scouts of America who have a genuine desire to develop their knowledge, skills, and competence for being an effective commissioner; and, to use that training to ensure that the very best Scouting programs are offered to the youth members in their Councils.

The selected curriculum is designed to motivate degree candidates to reach their full potential by offering the very latest training information available. The format offers the opportunity to earn one degree each year (Bachelor or Masters). Those candidates who have completed the 3rd year on instruction and their Doctoral Thesis/Project are eligible to earn their Doctorate of Commissioner Science degree.

The faculty and staff are composed of knowledgeable and motivated adult Scouters. Instructors provide leadership and classroom training for both new and experienced commissioners.

The course form contains information about the specific requirements for the degree programs, and a listing of the official course numbers and their descriptions. By carefully studying the information, a participant can plan a curriculum that best suits his/her needs. By setting and attaining individual training goals, a commissioner is better prepared to serve the units that he/she represents.
