

ITOLS What to Bring & What to Expect

REFERENCE: Scouts BSA Handbook, chapter 9 "Camping"

Overnight gear, outdoor essentials and appropriate clothing are the heart of camping equipment. Carry a light load of only what you need to keep yourself safe and make a good camp; leave all unnecessary items at home. Use lightweight backpacking tents for two only — no wall or large recreational-type tents.

- Water bottle (potable water will be provided)
- Matches and fire starters
- Sun protection
- Clothing for the season
- Tent, ground cloth
- Sleeping bag OR 2-3 blankets; pillow
- Sleeping pad
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Flashlight

PERSONAL HYGIENE

- Toothbrush & Toothpaste, Dental Floss
- Deodorant
- Comb
- Required Medications

PERSONAL STUFF

- · Full Field (Class A) Uniform
- · Watch with alarm capability
- Camera
- Sunglasses
- Gloves (for work and warmth)
- Extra Shoes and Socks

YOU MUST BRING FOR COURSE WORK

- Pocketknife
- First-aid kit
- BSA Medical Forms (A and B)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Personal Music Devices
- Electronic Games
- Expensive jewelry
