We will also have one scheduled Merit Badge practice day on Sunday, May 4, 2025 from 2-6pm at the Council Office/Scout Shop and it will be mandatory as well.

Please plan to arrive at Camp Post on Monday, June 16 by 10am. You will sleep in the bunkhouses while at Camp Post. We will have several days of training, merit badge practice (if time allows), walk through, and some fun activities including preparing for Summer Cub Day, which we will be hosting, Saturday, June 21st.

Sunday, June 22nd will be the start of Camp Post Summer Camp.

After campers leave on Saturday, June 28 we will clean campsites, buildings, go through program supplies and load it all onto the trailer. We will depart Camp Post as soon as that is finished, and you will have Sunday and Monday off.

We will meet up again at the Scout Office on Tuesday, July 1 at 8am to load up personal gear and head to Camp Tres Ritos. We will arrive at TR sometime in the afternoon. We will focus on personal gear the first day then focus on camp set up the rest of the week. You will sleep in wall tents. There is an outlet near most tents capable of charging your phone or running an alarm clock. No heaters or electric blankets allowed in tents.

We will do some hiking during staff week. Plan to hike to Angostura Meadow and possibly Jicarita Peak early Friday, July 4. If we have everything done, we will spend Saturday, July 5 in Taos where you can shop, eat out, visit the gorge, go bowling, watch a movie, or whatever we decide to do.

Don't forget to bring money for those activities. Sunday, July 6 will begin camp week. We will continue with the program through Friday. All campers will depart Saturday morning July 12. We will go to Taos that afternoon to relax and have dinner. Campers will arrive for our second week of camp on Sunday, July 13. We do plan to have Pecos Packers both of those weeks.

After campers leave on Saturday, July 19 we will clean campsites, buildings, go through program supplies and load it all onto the trailer. We will have dinner at Main Street Café. We will depart Camp Tres Ritos before lunch on Sunday, July 20 and expect to be back at Camp Post to unload the trailer(s) by 5pm.
