PERSONAL OVERNIGHT CAMPING GEAR

- Tent with poles, stakes, ground cloths, and lines
- Sleeping bag, or blanket
- Sleeping pad
- Pocketknife
- First-aid kit
- Extra clothing
- Rain gear
- Water bottle
- Flashlight
- Matches and fire starters (optional)
- Sun protection
- Compass (if you have one)
- Clothing for the season (warm-weather or cold-weather)
- Backpack/Daypack
- CLEANUP KIT (Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Comb, Washcloth, Towel)
- Scout Handbook (optional)
- Notebook or paper
- Pencil or pen
- Sunglasses
- Gloves (optional)
