


Registering for National Jamboree 2021 on the National Website

1. Go to this website
JAMBOREE.Scouting.org
2. Scroll down and look for the area for Jamboree Participants, Service Team, Council Resource



3. On the next screen you will be prompted that each person must have their own MyScouting Account

- All applicants must have a current BSA membership.
- All applicants must have their own My.Scouting accounts, *regardless of age*. You must not add a youth's BSA member ID to the parent's My.Scouting account.
- If the applicant does not have a My.Scouting account, use the “Create Account” button below to create an account first.
- The username and password to the *applicant's* My.Scouting account will be needed to access the Jamboree application.
- The BSA member number must be linked in the profile of the applicant's My.Scouting account.
- The Jamboree application is populated from the data in the My.Scouting account. *Make sure your information is correct in My.Scouting before you begin the Jamboree application!* The functionality to update profile information only exists in My.Scouting, not in the Jamboree application.
- **Attention International applicants:** Verification of membership and good standing by your National Scout Organization is required. Please be aware that there may be a delay of 60 or more days before your application may move into the placement phase.

Buttons: CREATE ACCOUNT, APPLY NOW

If your Scout does not already have an account, then you must create an account. If your Scout already has an account you can just click apply now. If you click apply now you must know the individual's My.Scouting username & Password. Parents can not log in with their username and password to register a Scout since registrations are attached to your own personal My.Scouting account.

4. If you need to create an account this next screen can be confusing. Make sure that the information entered is for the Scout that will be registering for the National Jamboree.

5. Click next and then once you successfully create the My.Scouting account for your Scout go back to the website JAMBOREE.Scouting.org and click to register as a participant. Then sign in with the Scout's account to create a 2021 National Jamboree registration. Make sure to select Black Hills Area Council 695 as your council.
