REGISTRATION: Please complete registration online as a Pack (preferably) or have the parent register individual scouts. Paper registration forms may be accepted at the MSC scout office. Forms are provided to help Pack leader with ease of online registration.



WHO CAN ATTEND:

- Scouts that will be 5 years of age / entering Kindergarten in the fall (Lion) through 11 years of age and entering 5th grade (Webelo/Arrow of Light).
- <u>Adults volunteering</u>: We strongly encourage adults to find day care for their younger children. If this is not possible, please include them as a Tag-along on your Pack registration and include BSA Health forms for each child.
- Please be aware that Day Camp is a Cub Scout activity, and some Tag-a-longs may not have the abilities to participate in some stations as they are created for scouts 6-11 years old. <u>Tag-a-longs</u>, Lions, and Tigers must stay with parent or guardian.
