

DOES SCOUTING WORK?


Scouting was put to the test over the course of three years, when a research team from Tufts University worked with the Boy Scouts of America to measure the character attributes of

both Scouts and non-Scouts. The project surveyed nearly 1,800 Cub Scouts and nearly 400 non-Scouts. See the results below.
