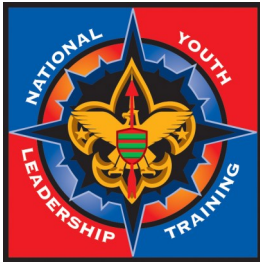


National Youth Leadership Training 2019

What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program designed for Councils to provide youth members with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home Units and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

Why Should I Participate

Through the NYLT course, participants gain skills that will help them become a better leader in Scouts, school, and life. These skills include Communication, Finding Your Vision, Developing a Team, Event Planning, and Problem Solving. By learning these skills, Scouts become more effective leaders.

What Should I Expect

NYLT is a weeklong course held at RSR in Morris. The course is run by the youth staff with adult supervision. The SPL runs all meetings and events. Participants will be assigned to patrols upon arrival, from there, the course will function as a model Troop for the duration of the course. Patrols will elect Patrol Leaders who will attend daily PLC meetings. The course includes training sessions, games, Patrol activities, Patrol projects, and an outpost on the last night of the course.
