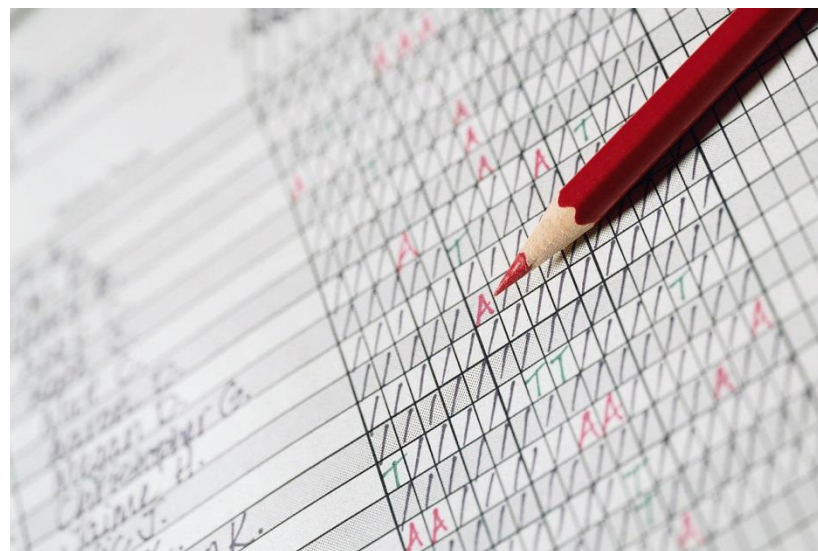

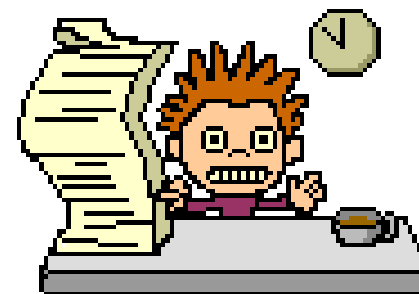




Arrival Day!

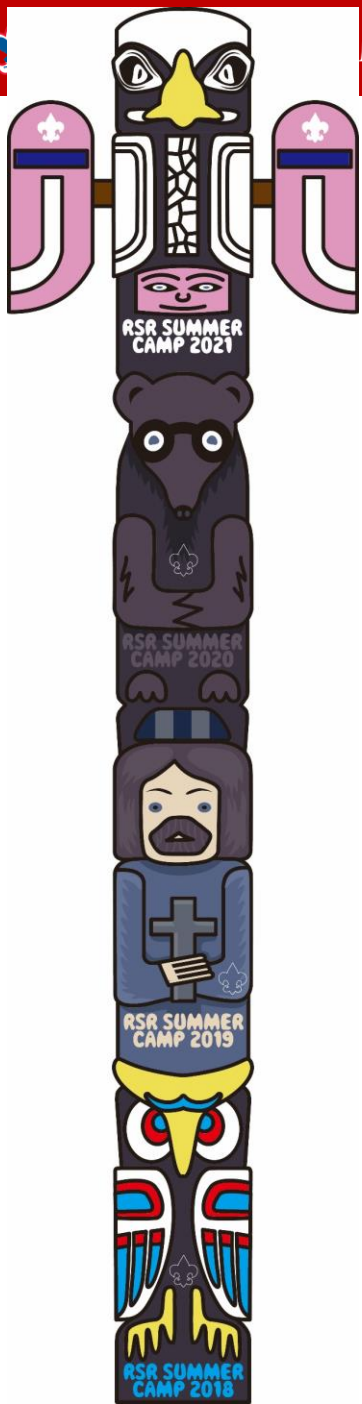
