



Hi, A word from your Camp Director about Corona Virus,

We have been monitoring the information coming out of the CDC and other government agencies. Additionally, we have been in touch with the Grundy County Health Department, the Council Medical Officer, and the Boy Scouts of America as well as listening to our government experts. During summer camp we will be taking the following additional measures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our campers, staff, and visitors:

- We will have a health officer on site 24/7 and hand washing stations throughout camp.
- When scouts and leaders enter camp, we will be reviewing their medical forms as in the past, but we will also be taking each person's temperature and asking some simple questions about recent health and exposure.
- Each of our program areas will have hand sanitizer and we will be requesting all scouts to use it when they enter the area.
- We are looking into supplying participants with personal hand sanitizer.
- All KYBOs will be supplied with hand sanitizer.
- We are cleaning program areas before you arrive and routinely throughout the week.
- So, what if someone shows respiratory symptoms? The person will be quarantined in the health office and parents will be notified and requested to take the person to their physician. If test results come back as positive, we will notify the Grundy County Health Department who will be working with The Center for Disease Control.
- When I became an Eagle Scout, one of the required merit badges was **Public Health**. It was very beneficial to me and I use the information I learned every day. As a special offering, we will be offering the PUBLIC HEALTH merit badge this summer.
