


## **Webelos Woods**

### **What is Webelos Woods?**

Webelos Woods is a weekend of camping and fun for Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts. Troop Guides from Scouts BSA will lead dens through activities designed to give scouts a taste of the independence, self-reliance, and new experiences they can look forward to when they cross over from Cub Scouts to Scouts BSA.

### **What will scouts do at Webelos Woods?**

One of the biggest differences in Scouts BSA is use of the patrol method, where youth are leading youth. Scouts will work as a patrol with other scouts from their unit. Smaller dens or individual scouts can also form patrols. Their Scouts BSA Troop Guide will help the patrol lead themselves for the day. Patrols will get to design their patrol name, yell, and flag.

Activities on Saturday will be different from those commonly provided at other events so scouts can experience things they couldn't when they were younger.

### **What will Cubmasters, Den Leaders and Parents do?**

We must have adult participants for safety and overnight camping, but adults can step back during Saturday activities and let the scouts do the work. It's a great time to observe some of the differences in Cub Scouts and Scouts BSA.

If you plan to be an adult leader in Scouts BSA, we'll be offering the Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills class (required training for Asst. Scoutmasters) to help you prepare. This hands-on program gives adult leaders a practical introduction to the patrol method of a Scout-led troop by teaching many of the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. In addition, the teaching methods, activities, and games model the variety of teaching used in effective and engaging Scouting programs.

### **What should I bring?**

We are providing meals for Saturday, so you only need to pack your personal camping gear and a quick Sunday breakfast.

- Clothes (bring layers)
- Scout uniform
- Extra socks
- Jacket/coat
- Closed toe comfortable shoes (lots of walking)
- Rain gear/poncho
- Toiletries
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping pad
- Pillow
- Medications
- Folding camp chair
- Spending money for trading post
- Day pack
- Grab and go type breakfast for Sunday

### **What will accommodations be like?**

You will be assigned to a bunk house with 4 beds. There are no mattresses or electricity. You may also bring your own tent or hammock.

**Should we register individually or as a unit?**

Either is fine, but please make sure you select your correct unit number during registration so that we can group you with your unit.

Also, when registering a youth, please put the names of family members who will be attending with them in the field called buddies. This will help us arrange families together in cabin spaces.

**What should we do when we arrive?**

Please make plans to arrive and check-in as a unit. Your first stop will be Headquarters where you'll be given your campsite assignment.


You may drive a vehicle to drop your gear at the campsite, then return to the parking area. Vehicles must remain in the parking area during camp for safety.

**General Notes:**

- Use the locked trash cans in the campsite. Put bagged trash by roadway before Sunday check-out.
- Do not store food in tents or cabins.
- No smoking or vaping in sight of scouts.
- There will be a medic on duty.
- Drinking water will be obtained from campsites or buildings.
- Always use the buddy system.
- Units should complete and bring Part A and B medical forms with you.
- We will wear uniforms to evening flags, supper, vespers and campfire.





## Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Interstate 81



- 1) Take exit 23 onto US 11 E South
- 2) Travel about 6.9 miles then Turn Right on TN 113 N
- 3) After about 2.8 miles turn left on Thompson Road
- 4) In 1 mile continue onto Grassy Valley Road
- 5) Go .2 miles turn left onto Ninny Ridge Rd
- 6) Travel 1.2 miles turn left onto Bingham Road
- 7) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett

## Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Highway 11W



- 1) Turn on Melinda Ferry Road (TN-344S)
- 2) Travel 2.4 miles then Turn Right onto Lee Valley Road
- 3) Travel about 2.4 miles turn Right onto Bingham Road
- 4) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett
