- Packs are asked to prepare a treat bag to hand out during trick or treats
- Carved pumpkin – You may carve it in advance or at your campsite during the event. Bring your own carving tools, pumpkins, and lights. Bring your carved pumpkin to the costume contest.

You will be assigned to a bunk house with 4 beds. There are no mattresses or electricity. When registering, please list the names of family who will attend with you so we may group you correctly for room assignments.

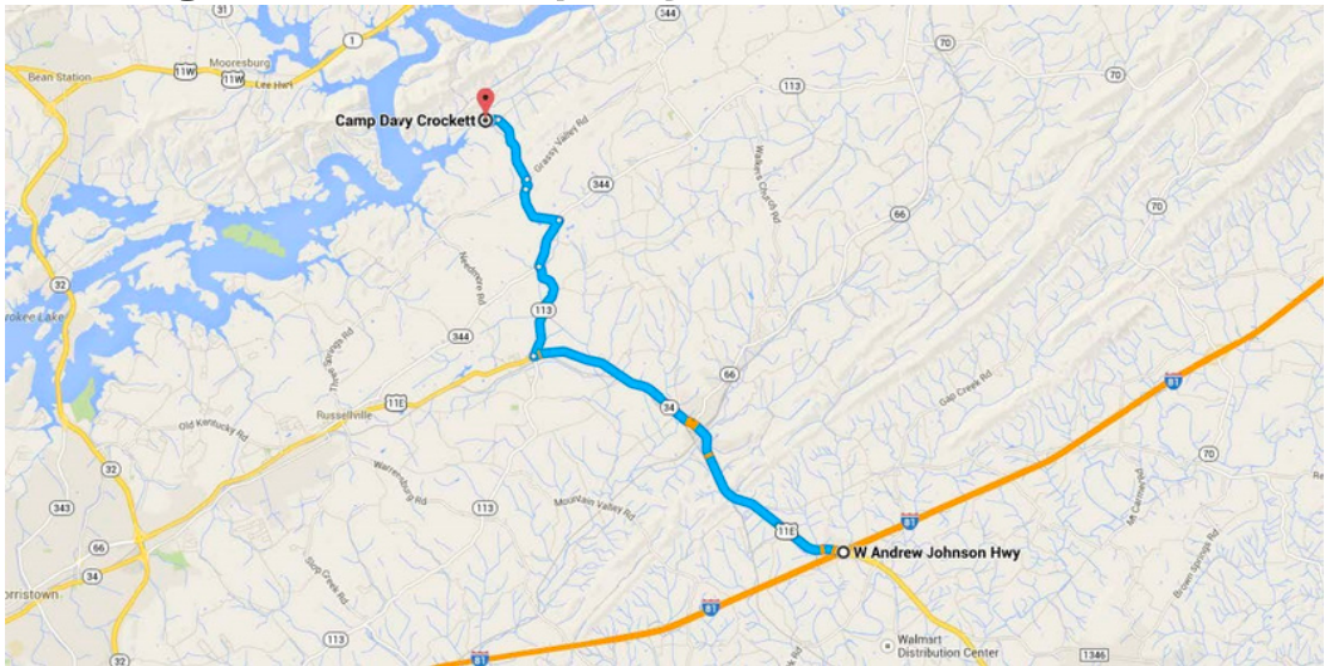

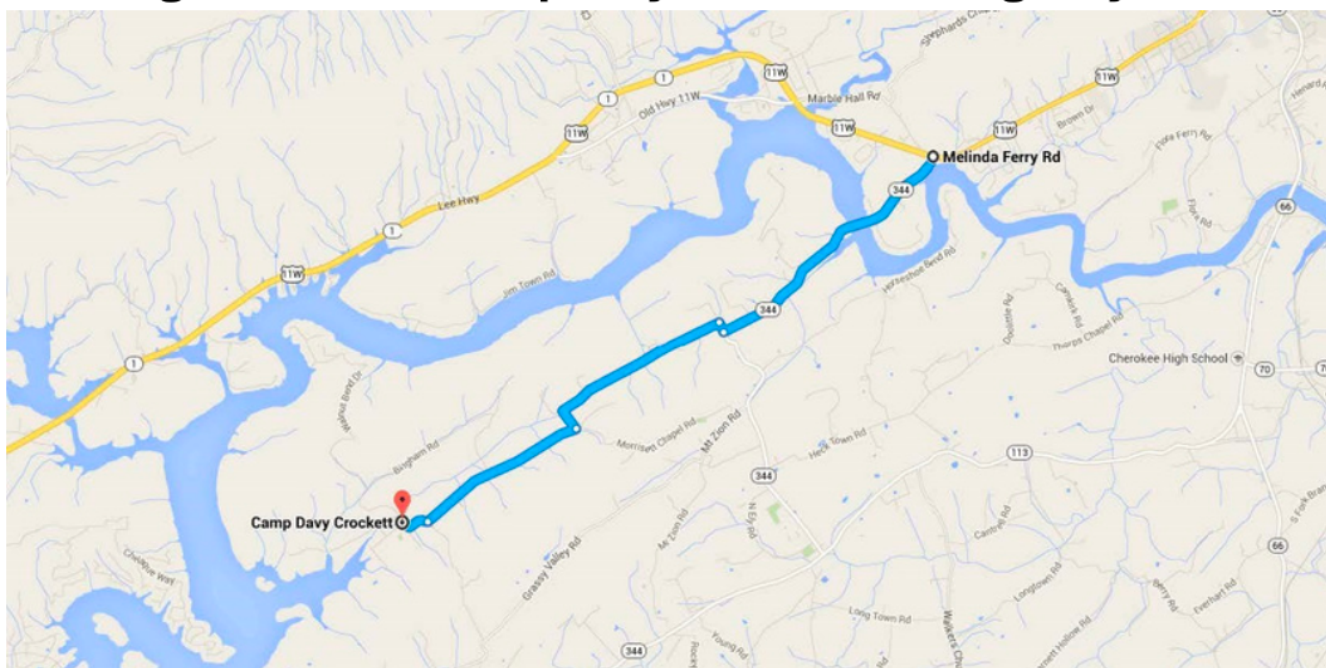

Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Interstate 81



- 1) Take exit 23 onto US 11 E South
- 2) Travel about 6.9 miles then Turn Right on TN 113 N
- 3) After about 2.8 miles turn left on Thompson Road
- 4) In 1 mile continue onto Grassy Valley Road
- 5) Go .2 miles turn left onto Ninny Ridge Rd
- 6) Travel 1.2 miles turn left onto Bingham Road
- 7) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett

Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Highway 11W



- 1) Turn on Melinda Ferry Road (TN-344S)
- 2) Travel 2.4 miles then Turn Right onto Lee Valley Road
- 3) Travel about 2.4 miles turn Right onto Bingham Road
- 4) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett
