
Cub Scout Haunted Adventure Weekend

Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Interstate 81



- 1) Take exit 23 onto US 11 E South
- 2) Travel about 6.9 miles then Turn Right on TN 113 N
- 3) After about 2.8 miles turn left on Thompson Road
- 4) In 1 mile continue onto Grassy Valley Road
- 5) Go .2 miles turn left onto Ninny Ridge Rd 6) Travel 1.2 miles turn left onto Bingham Road
- 7) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett

Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Highway 11W



- Turn on Melinda Ferry Road (TN-344S)
 Travel 2.4 miles then Turn Right onto Lee Valley Road
- 3) Travel about 2.4 miles turn Right onto Bingham Road
- 4) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett
