If you are camping overnight, you may drive a vehicle to drop your gear at the campsite, then return to the parking area. Vehicles must remain in the parking area during camp for safety.

What should I bring?

- Warm clothes (layers)
- Extra socks
- Jacket/coat/hats/gloves
- Closed toe comfortable shoes (lots of walking)
- Rain gear/poncho
- Toiletries
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping pad
- Pillow
- Medications
- Folding camp chair
- Spending money on the trading post

Complete and bring Part A and B [Health Forms](#) with you (adults and scouts). You will need to have these with you should you need medical attention.

In addition to your regular camp gear, you'll need some special things for this event:

- Sunday breakfast
- Costume
- Trick or Treat bag
- Packs are asked to prepare a trunk and treat bags to hand out during Trunk or Treat Saturday evening.
- Carved pumpkin – You may carve it in advance or at your campsite during the event. Bring your own carving tools, pumpkins, and lights. Bring your carved pumpkin to the pool shelter 5:00 PM Saturday.

What will accommodations be like?

You will be assigned to a bunk house with 4 beds. There are no mattresses or electricity. When registering, please list the names of family who will attend with you so we may group you correctly for room assignments.

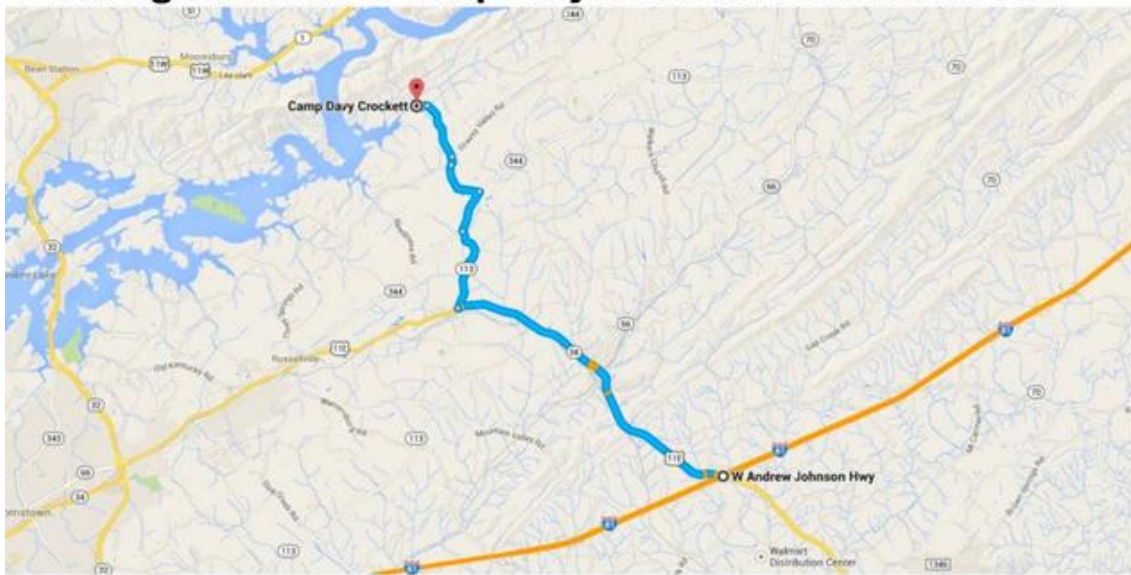

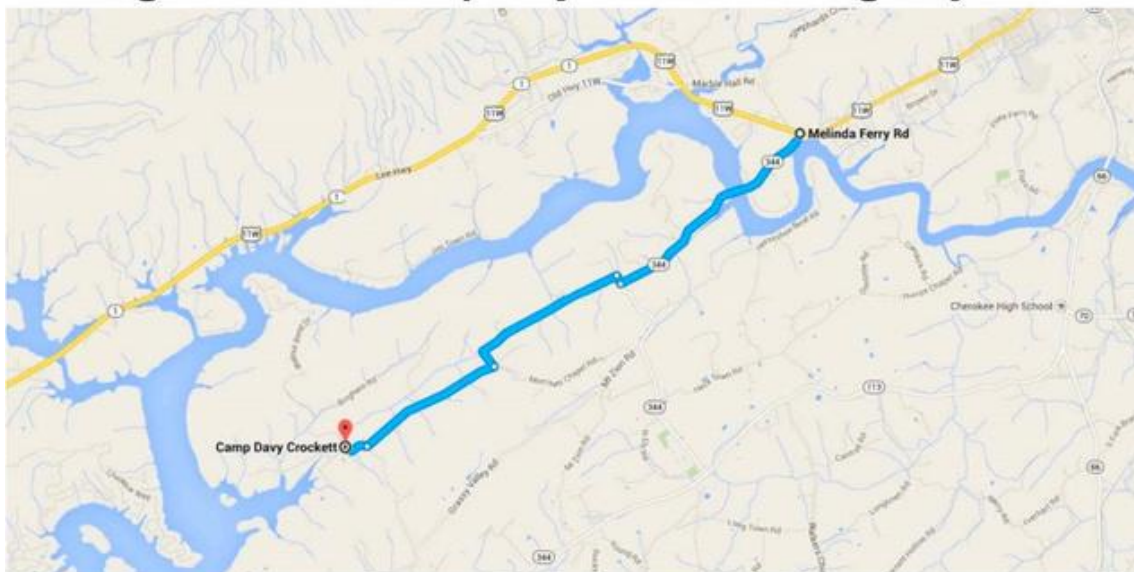

Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Interstate 81



- 1) Take exit 23 onto US 11 E South
- 2) Travel about 6.9 miles then Turn Right on TN 113 N
- 3) After about 2.8 miles turn left on Thompson Road
- 4) In 1 mile continue onto Grassy Valley Road
- 5) Go .2 miles turn left onto Ninny Ridge Rd
- 6) Travel 1.2 miles turn left onto Bingham Road
- 7) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett

Driving Directions to Camp Davy Crockett from Highway 11W



- 1) Turn on Melinda Ferry Road (TN-344S)
- 2) Travel 2.4 miles then Turn Right onto Lee Valley Road
- 3) Travel about 2.4 miles turn Right onto Bingham Road
- 4) In .3 miles turn left into Camp Davy Crockett
