



Personal Camping Equipment List

- Tent/stakes
- Tarp for ground (under your tent)
- Day pack with Scout “10 Essentials”
- Field and Activity uniform shirts
- Change of clothes (check the weather)
- Hoodie or jacket (check the weather)
- Rain gear (check the weather)
- Sleeping clothes
- Ball cap/hat
- Sunglasses
- Boots or shoes (no sandals or open toe shoes)
- Shower towel (outside showers only) *
- Shower shoes/Crocs (outside showers only) *
- Sleeping bag (appropriate for the expected temps), blanket, pillow
- Ground pad / air mattress (no electricity so bring your own pump)
- Mess Kit (plate/bowl, utensils, cup) **
- Pocket Knife (no fixed blades)
- Flashlight/head lamp with extra batteries
- Nalgene-type water bottle
- Scout handbook, pen/pencil/note pad
- Camp chair
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent (PLEASE bring what you need in case you are allergic to stings)
- Personal hygiene kit
- Medications
- Any food/drinks you would like to bring in case you get hungry between meals

** To follow BSA Leave No Trace principles, we will NOT provide paper plates, bowls, plastic utensils, or plastic/foam cups. Please bring your own mess gear! **

* Toilet facilities are provided by porta-potties.

* Showers are limited in number and outside only. Bring a bathing suit.
