Baden Powell, the founder of Scouting, began Wood Badge training in 1919 as a way to ensure the leaders of Scout troops were properly trained. Since then, Wood Badge has been held worldwide, providing advanced leadership training to thousands of Scout leaders.

Wood Badge builds upon the best traditions and experiences of the Boy Scouts of America and also draws from a wide range of courses within and beyond the bounds of Scouting to present leadership theory and team development all taught in the setting of the Scouting experience.
