Friday:

- <u>Arrivals and Registration (17:00 22:00) Baumholder Camp Gound BEL Registration</u>
- As attendees arrive, they register in the Main Tent with Medical Forms
 - <u>Staff Leadership Meeting (19:00 20:00) Registration</u>
- Lodge Leadership meet to discuss the rundown of the weekend and coordinate evening events.
 - Gathering (20:00-20:30) Registration

All Attendees are called together to go over the Rundown for the Weekend and make any Announcements. Attendees are sorted into eight groups:

- 1. Ordeal Candidates
- 2. Elangomats
- 3. Brotherhood Candidates
- 4. Nimats
- 5. Ceremonies Circle
- 6. Service Circle
- 7. Cook Team
- 8. Youth Leadership

Program for Attendees will depend on the group they volunteer for.

- Program Training (20:30 21:00) Dining Tent
 - 1. Ordeal Candidates are led to the Setup Camp, and prep Bed Roll
 - 2. Elangomats will split into their respective functions (Ordeal Master, Head Elangomats, Elangomats), go over the schedule and then receive training.
 - 3. Brotherhood Candidates will fold in with the Service Program
 - 4. Nimats will go over the schedule and receive training.
 - 5. Ceremonies will split into the respective roles as well as ring support, go over the schedule and then move to the Wilderness to practice the pre-ordeal ceremony.
 - 6. Youth in the Service Program will go over the Schedule and To-Do list for the weekend.
 - 7. Cook Team discuss their plans for the weekend.
 - 8. Youth Leadership run the individual Trainings.
- Ordeal Preparation (20:00 21:00) *Registration*

Elangomats meet up with the Ordeal Candidates at the Bonfire Site, take them back to Registration, split them into Clans, acquaint them with their respective Elangomats, and prepare for the Ordeal.

The chosen Ceremonies Team performs the Pre-Ordeal Ceremony for the Candidates, who are then shown sleeping areas.

- Leadership Meeting (23:30 24:00) *Dining Tent*
- All Staff meet to discuss the rundown of the weekend and coordinate evening events.
 - <u>Lights Out (24:00)</u>: Arrowmen are expected to be quiet, keep lights off and go to sleep soon.
 - 1. Ceremonies Locations are weather dependent and therefore not given above.
 - 2. Service at this event will be directed towards cleanup for Intercamp and MWR support projects.





Saturday:

 - Ordeal Wake-Up (6:00 7:00) Northwestern Fields
- Elangomats pick up the Ordeal Breakfasts from the Mess Hall and wake up the Ordeal Candidates. Ordeal candidates pack up their gear and eat.
 - Ordeal Service Begins (7:00 12:00) Misc.
- Ordeal Candidates start working until Lunch. Spell Elangomats cover for Elangomats so they can eat Breakfast.
 - Lodge Breakfast (7:00 8:00) Dining Tent
- The Lodge eats Breakfast.
 - Service Crews Form (8:00 8:30) Dining Tent
- Nimats and Service Members form Clans.
 - Service Crews Begin Work (8:30 12:00) Misc.
- Service Crews start working alongside Ordeal Candidates.
 - <u>Ceremonies Teams Practice (8:00 12:00) Wilderness</u>
- Ceremonies Teams practice the Brotherhood and Ordeal Ceremonies in secluded areas.
 - Cook Teams Prepare Lunch (8:00 12:00) Dining Tent
- Lunch for Ordeal Candidates and Lodge Members is prepared.
 - Ordeal and Lodge Lunch (12:00 13:00) Dining Tent / Misc.
